# A BILL FOR

An Act relating to terms of members of the capitol planning commission.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section eighteen A point two (18A.2), Code 1962,
- 2 is amended by adding thereto the following:
- 3 "The terms of office of all members of the capitol planning
- 4 commission in office on the effective date of this Act are con-
- 5 tinued to May 1, 1967 on which date all terms shall terminate.
- 6 Prior to said date appointments shall be made for succeeding
- 7 members as follows:
- 8 From the House of Representatives, one for a term of two years
- 9 and one for a term of four years.
- 10 From the Senate, one for a term of two years and one for a
- 11 term of four years.
- 12 For successors to nonofficial appointees one for a term of
- 13 two years and two for terms of four years.
- 14 All terms of members of the commission shall begin on May 1
- 15 of each odd-numbered year beginning with May 1, 1967."

## EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 148

The original Act creating the capitol planning commission did not specify when the terms would begin and did not provide for continuity of membership. This bill would simply such provisions .
