A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section two hundred seventy-nine point twenty-five (279.25), Code 1962, relating to purchase of school supplies.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred seventy-nine point twenty-
- 2 five (279.25), Code 1962, is amended by striking from lines
- 3 seven (7) to nine (9) the words "to an amount not exceeding two
- 4 hundred dollars in any one year" and inserting in lieu thereof
- 5 the words "as deemed necessary by the board of directors".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 171

This bill takes out a limitation of the law which is not realistic for our present day school systems. The restriction of \$200 for books, maps, charts, and apparatus for a present day school building is entirely inadequate. This provision of the statute, of necessity, is now violated by most school districts of the state.
