A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the effect of a transfer of persons from
the Iowa training schools to the men's and women's
reformatory.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred eighteen point ninety-one
 2 (218.91), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding at the end
 3 thereof the following sentence: "Subsequent to a transfer
 4 made under this section, the person transferred shall be
 5 subject to all the provisions of law and regulations of the
 6 institution to which he is transferred, and for the purposes
 7 of chapter seven hundred forty-five (745) of the Code such
 8 person shall be regarded as having been committed to the
 9 institution."

1 Sec. 2. Section two hundred forty-five point eleven (245.11),
 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking the last word of line
 3 five (5) and all of lines six (6) and seven (7) and inserting
 4 in lieu thereof the following: ", and for the purposes of chapter
 5 seven hundred forty-five (745) of the Code, a person transferred
 6 from the training school for girls to the women's reformatory
 7 shall be regarded as having been committed thereto."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 203

At the present time, any inmate at Anamosa who is a transferee from the boys training school at Eldora is not liable to the law of escape. Girls, however, are liable. Consequently, we have a situation where if a woman transferee escapes from the women's reformatory, she may be prosecuted for the crime of escape; but a man transferee may not.
