A BILL FOR

An Act relating to public libraries.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred seventy-eight point three
- 2 (378.3), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 period in line eight (8) the following: "Free municipal
- 4 public libraries receiving funds for county-wide public
- 5 library service on a contract basis may have one non-resident
- 6 trustee board member appointed by the mayor with the approval
- 7 of the county board of supervisors."
- 1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred seventy-eight point five
- 2 (378.5), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 word and figures "section 378.2" in line three (3) the
- 4 following: "and 378.3".
- 1 Sec. 3. Section three hundred seventy-eight point seven
- 2 (378.7), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 word and figures "section 378.2" in line six (6) the following:
- 4 "and 378.3".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 21

Section 1 provides for county representation on town library boards of trustees when county-wide contracts and funds become available through county boards of supervisors. Section 2 removes non-resident restriction.
