A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the appointment of a deputy collector by the county treasurer.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred forty point two (340.2),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking lines twenty-seven (27)
- 3 through thirty (30) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 4 "The county treasurer may appoint, in any city having a popula-
- 5 tion of six thousand (6,000) or over which is not the county seat,
- 6 or any city next in size to the county seat in population, a resi-
- 7 dent deputy collector of taxes for such".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 222

Statute now permits the county treasurer in counties with a city of 6,000 population or over which is not the county seat to appoint a resident deputy collector of taxes for the city and vicinity. The purpose of this bill is to permit county treasurers to appoint a deputy collector of taxes for cities, next in size in population to a county seat, which are in need of such a deputy but which are under 6,000 in population.

HOUSE FILE 222

- 1 Amend House File 222 as follows:
- 2 1. By striking all after the figures "(27)" in line two (2)
- 3 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "through
- 4 thirty-one (31) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 5 "In any county in which there exists a city or town, not the
- 6 county seat, the treasurer may appoint a resident deputy
- 7 collector of taxes for such city or town under bond as provided
- 8 for."
- 9 2. By adding the following section:
- 10 "Section three hundred forty point two (340.2), Code 1962,
- 11 is further amended by inserting after the word 'city' in line
- 12 thirty-six (36) of said section the words 'or town'."
