- 2 (111A.6), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from
- 3 lines forty-eight (48) and forty-nine (49) the words "having
- 4 a population in excess of ninety thousand".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 249

The larger populated counties have sufficient valuation to secure funds for major projects; it is the smaller populated counties that need bonding authority.
