A BILL FOR

An Act to require a statement of the taxpayer's resident school district on his state income tax return.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section four hundred twenty-two point twenty-one
2 (422.21), Code 1962, is amended by adding at the end thereof the
3 following paragraph:

4 "A space shall be provided by the tax commission, on the
5 prescribed income tax form, wherein the taxpayer shall enter the
6 name of the school district of his residence. Such place shall
7 be indicated by prominent type. A nonresident taxpayer shall
8 so indicate. Unless such information is supplied on the tax
9 return it shall not be considered as completed and shall be re-
10 turned to the taxpayer. The provisions of this paragraph shall
11 not apply to corporations."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 271

This bill merely requires each taxpayer to furnish the name of his resident school district on his state income tax return.
