# A BILL FOR

An Act to change the age limit for a child to be eligible for aid to dependent children.

*passed House 4/7 ayes 68 nays 43*  
Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred thirty-nine point one
- 2 (239.1), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from line
- 3 three (3) of subsection four (4) of such section the word
- 4 "eighteen" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "twenty-one
- 5 (21)".

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 304

Present statutes provides a child under the age of 18 regularly attending school is eligible for aid to dependent children. This bill raises the age limit to 21.

- 14 gainful employment.
