An Act relating to the powers and duties of the state board  
of social welfare.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred thirty-four point six (234.6),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:
- 3 "Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in chapters
- 4 two hundred thirty-nine (239), two hundred forty-one (241),
- 5 two hundred forty-one (241A), and two hundred forty-nine (249)
- 6 of the Code relating to the consideration of income and resources
- 7 of claimants for assistance, the state board shall make such
- 8 rules and regulations as may be necessary to qualify for federal
- 9 aid in the assistance programs administered by the board."

**EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 308**

This bill enables the State Board of Social Welfare to make such rules and regulations as may be necessary to exempt from income consideration in the various assistance programs those payments made under the provisions of the several titles of the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964, or the provisions of other federal programs such as manpower and development and training or cooperative work-study programs for high school youth. Such exemptions shall be consistent with federal policy covering Iowa's participation in the grant-in-aid provisions of the several titles of the Social Security Act.
