## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to anti-hog-cholera virus and serum dealer permits.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred sixty-six point three (166.3),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:
- 3 "No pharmacy licensed under chapter one hundred fifty-five (155)
- 4 of the Code shall be required to obtain a dealer's permit to deal
- 5 in biological products.
- 1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred sixty-six point ten (166.10),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from line one (1) of sub-
- 3 section two (2) of such section the words "one dollar" and insert-
- 4 ing in lieu thereof the words "five (5) dollars".

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 316

The purpose of this bill is to exempt licensed pharmacies from having to obtain a dealer's permit to sell anti-hog-cholera virus and serum. The bill also increases the annual cost of the dealer's permit from \$1 to \$5.
