A BILL FOR

An Act to legalize and validate the proceedings for the organization and establishment of the Armstrong Benefited Fire District, in the counties of Emmet and Kossuth, state of Iowa, and declaring said district a duly and legally organized corporate body as provided by law.

WHEREAS, the Armstrong Benefited Fire District, in the counties of Emmet and Kossuth, state of Iowa, was organized and established pursuant to the provisions of chapter three hundred fifty-seven A (357A), Code 1962, and the existence of said district is of general public interest and vital to the public interest and welfare of the area contained within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, doubts have arisen concerning the validity and legal sufficiency of the proceedings for the organization and establishment of said district, and it is deemed advisable and necessary to put such doubts and all others that might arise concerning same forever at rest; NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. That all proceedings heretofore taken in
2 connection with the organization, creation, and establish-
3 ment of the Armstrong Benefited Fire District, in the counties
4 of Emmet and Kossuth, state of Iowa, are hereby declared to be
5 valid, legal and sufficient to create and establish the body
6 corporate and politic known as the Armstrong Benefited Fire
7 District in the counties of Emmet and Kossuth, state of Iowa,
8 and the same are hereby legalized, validated, and confirmed,
9 and said fire district is declared to be a legal entity under
10 the provisions of and for the purposes contemplated in chapter
11 three hundred fifty-seven A (357A) of the Code.

1 Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall

- 2 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
- 3 publication in The Armstrong Journal, a newspaper published
- 4 at Armstrong, Iowa, without expense to the state.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 343

This bill legalizes and validates the proceedings for the organization and establishment of the Armstrong Benefited Fire District in the counties of Emmet and Kossuth and declares this district to be a duly and legally organized corporate body.
