A BILL FOR

An Act for an additional appropriation from the general fund to the board of control of state institutions for use of Woodward state hospital and school.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
- 2 of the state of Iowa to the board of control of state institutions
- 3 the sum of three hundred nine thousand (309,000) dollars to re-
- 4 locate the water supplying facilities of the Woodward state hos-
- 5 pital and school above and beyond the replacement value of these
- 6 facilities being reimbursed by the United States corps of engineers.
- 1 Sec. 2. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June 30, 1969,
- 2 of the appropriation of this Act made by the Sixty-first General
- 3 Assembly shall revert to the general fund of the state as of
- 4 June 30, 1969.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 37

The aforesaid appropriation is needed to relocate the water supply facilities for the Woodward state hospital and school, Woodward, Iowa. The federal government is in the process of building the Saylorville Dam on the Des Moines river which will cause such present facilities to become inundated. The United States Corps of Engineers has agreed to reimburse the state of Iowa for the replacement value of such present facilities when replaced at the new location with the depreciated value absorbed by the state.
