A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter one hundred fourteen (114), Acts of the Sixtieth General Assembly, relating to the hours during which alcoholic liquor may be sold and consumed on the premises of licensed establishments.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred fourteen (114), Acts of the
- 2 Sixtieth General Assembly, is hereby amended by striking from
- 3 section sixteen (16) all of lines ten (10), eleven (11) and
- 4 twelve (12) and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "or
- 5 permit the consumption thereof between the hours of two (2)
- 6 a.m. and seven (7) a.m. on any week day, and between the hours
- 7 of one (1) a.m. on Sunday and seven (7) a.m. on the".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 416

This bill would extend the hours of legal sale on liquor one hour per day.

- 8 between the hours of two (2) a.m. and seven (7) a.m. on any week
- 9 day, and between the hours of one (1) a.m. on Sunday and seven (7)
- 10 a.m. on the following Monday, or".

2 filed May 12, 1965, as follows:
3 1. By striking the word "or" in line ten (10) and
4 inserting in lieu thereof the following "provided however,
5 that city and town councils and county boards of supervisors
6 are empowered to adopt ordinances or resolutions for
7 establishing the hours during which alcoholic beverages
8 may be sold and consumed on Sunday between the hours of
9 one (1) p.m. and twelve (12) o'clock on Sunday for
10 licensees whose business of selling alcoholic liquor and
11 beer as defined in chapter one hundred twenty-four (124)
12 of the Code does not constitute more than fifty (50)
13 percent of the gross business transacted therein, or".
14 2. By adding the following section:
15 "Sec. 2. Chapter one hundred twenty-three (123), Code
16 1962, as amended by chapters one hundred fourteen (114),
17 one hundred fifteen (115) and one hundred sixteen (116),
18 Acts of the Sixtieth General Assembly, is further amended
19 by adding the following two (2) new sections:
20 1. 'Establishments selling alcoholic liquors between
21 the hours of one (1) p.m. Sunday and twelve (12) o'clock
22 midnight, where permitted by the city or town council or
23 county board of supervisors the sum of two hundred fifty
24 (250) dollars for a permit to sell or dispense between
25 such hours. No permit shall be issued under the provisions
26 of this section unless such establishment is otherwise
27 licensed to sell beer and alcoholic beverages.'
28 2. 'Beer or alcoholic beverages sold between the hours
29 of one (1) p.m. Sunday and twelve (12) o'clock midnight
30 shall only be served to those seated at a table and it
31 shall be unlawful for any person to consume beer or
32 alcoholic beverages in such establishment during such
33 hours unless seated at a table.'"
