A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the eradication of bovine brucellosis.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred thirty-one (131), Acts
- 2 of the Sixtieth General Assembly, is hereby amended by striking
- 3 from section three (3), line one (1), the date "July 1, 1963"
- 4 and inserting in lieu thereof the date "July 1, 1965".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 417

It is the feeling of the division of animal industry that more time is needed to carry an educational program to all segments of the cattle industry. This has been attempted during the past year and it is our feeling that we have not reached a very large percentage of those directly affected. Calfhood vaccination in no way will affect our goal in reaching brucellosis modified-certified status in Iowa.

HOUSE FILE 417

- 2 the enacting clause and insert in lieu thereof the follow-
- 3 ing:
- 4 "Section 1. Chapter one hundred thirty-one
- 5 (131), Acts of the Sixtieth General Assembly, section three
- 6 (3), is hereby amended by striking in lines six (6) and seven (7) the
- 7 following: 'In a hardship case the department may issue a
- 8 permit for the movement of such animals providing it is
- 9 warranted.', and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 10 'In a hardship case the department may issue a permit for
- 11 the movement of female cattle not having met brucellosis
- 12 vaccination requirements, subject to brucellosis test conducted
- 13 at the owner's expense. At no time will indemnity be paid for
- 14 animals condemned to slaughter when tested under hardship
- 15 permit.'"
