## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the sentence of an individual convicted of bribery involving athletic contests.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section seven hundred thirty-nine point twelve
- 2 (739.12), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from lines
- 3 twenty-five (25) and twenty-six (26) the words "undergo imprison-
- 4 ment" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "to imprisonment in
- 5 the penitentiary".

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 452

The present statute provides that any individual convicted of bribery involving athletic contests shall be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding \$10,000 or undergo imprisonment not exceeding ten years, or both. The provision permits an individual convicted under this statute to spend up to a maximum of 10 years in the county jail. The purpose of this bill is to amend the law to provide that if an individual convicted of bribery involving athletic contests is to be imprisoned, the imprisonment shall be in the state penitentiary.
