A BILL FOR

An Act relating to displaying of lighted headlamps on motor vehicles upon a highway.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point three
2 hundred eighty-four (321.384), Code 1962, is hereby amended as
3 follows:

4 1. By striking from line three (3) of subsection one (1) of
5 such section the word "after" and inserting in lieu thereof the
6 word "before".

7 2. By striking from line three (3) of subsection one (1) of
8 such section the word "before" and inserting in lieu thereof the
9 word "after".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 5

The purpose of this bill is to require motor vehicles to display lighted headlamps upon a highway from one-half hour before sunset to one-half hour after sunrise. Present law requires motor vehicle headlamps to be displayed from one-half hour after sunset to one-half hour before sunrise.

HOUSE FILE 5

- 1 Amend House File 5 as follows:
2 1. Amend House File 5 by striking subsections 1 and 2 and
3 inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:
4 "1. By striking from lines two (2) and three (3) in subsection
5 one (1) the words "one-half hour after" and the words "one-half
6 hour before".
