A BILL FOR

An Act relating to judges and prosecuting attorneys furnishing certain information to the board of control.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred eighteen point ninety-seven
- 2 (218.97), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
- 3 following:
- 4 "To facilitate the work of the clinic and to aid in the reha-
- 5 bilitation of such prisoners, the trial judge and the prosecuting
- 6 attorney shall, when requested by the board, furnish the board
- 7 with such information as is provided the state board of parole
- 8 under section two hundred forty-seven point fifteen (247.15), of
- 9 the Code."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 523

Statute presently requires a trial judge and prosecuting attorney to furnish the State Board of Parole upon request a full statement of facts and circumstances regarding the offense committed by any individual under the jurisdiction of the board. This bill permits the Board of Control to obtain such information from the judge and attorney upon request.
