A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section one hundred six point twelve (106.12),
Code of 1962, relating to littering of public waters, ice
and land.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred six point twelve (106.12),
- 2 Code of 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto after subsection
- 3, two (2), line ten (10), the following new subsection. "No person
- 4 shall place, cause to be placed, throw or deposit onto or in any
- 5 of the waters, ice or land under the jurisdiction of the state any
- 6 cans, bottles, debris, garbage, refuse or other waste material of
- 7 any kind."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 567

At the present, there is no law that prohibits the littering of many of the public water and land areas of the state.
