## A BILL FOR

*passed on file 4/26  
substituted for SF 527-4/28*

An Act to disregard other income and resources as may be needed to implement a plan for achieving self-support by a recipient of aid for the blind.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred forty-one point three (241.3),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting in line sixteen (16)
- 3 after the word "disregarded" the following:
- 4 " , and for a period not in excess of twelve (12) months, such
- 5 additional amounts of other income and resources, in the case of
- 6 an individual who has a plan for achieving self-support approved
- 7 by the state board shall be disregarded".

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 573

This bill is necessary to comply with the 1962 amendments of the Federal Social Security Act which provide in addition to the standard disregard of income formula, the State Board of Social Welfare shall also disregard such other income or resources for one year as may be needed to implement a blind recipient's plan from achieving self-support.
