A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the office of the commissioner of public health.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Section one hundred thirty-five point three
2 (135.3), Code 1962, is hereby repealed and the following
3 enacted in lieu thereof:
4 "The commissioner shall not hold any other lucrative office
5 of this state, elective or appointive, during his term except
6 the commissioner may serve as an officer or member of the in-
7 structional staff of any of the state educational institutions
8 providing any additional duties and responsibilities do not
9 prohibit him from performing the duties of the office of com-
10 missioner."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 58

This bill permits the commissioner of public health to serve as an officer or member of the instructional staff of state educational institutions or colleges, but prohibits him from holding any other lucrative office.
