## A BILL FOR

*Passed on file 7/12  
substituted for SF 535-7/23*

An Act relating to permits for administering hog-cholera virus.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section one hundred sixty-six point sixteen (166.16),  
2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from lines eleven (11),  
3 twelve (12), and thirteen (13) of subsection five (5) of such  
4 section the words "including those persons who are holders of  
5 valid, unrevoked written permits to administer the same".

1 Sec. 2. Sections one hundred sixty-six point seventeen (166.17)  
2 through one hundred sixty-six point twenty-eight (166.28), and  
3 sections one hundred sixty-six point thirty (166.30), one hundred  
4 sixty-six point thirty-one (166.31), one hundred sixty-six point  
5 thirty-three (166.33), and one hundred sixty-six point forty  
6 (166.40), Code 1962, are hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 3. Section one hundred sixty-six point thirty-two (166.32),  
2 Code 1962, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu  
3 thereof:

4 "The department shall upon written request, without charge,  
5 send a complete list of every manufacturer and dealer licensed to  
6 manufacture or distribute biological products to every county  
7 agent. Any necessary changes and corrections to the list shall be  
8 sent to such agent at least once every three (3) months."

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 586

This bill, which is being submitted for the purpose of Code editing, is to repeal those sections of the Code which refer to permits necessary to administer hog-cholera virus. The use of live hog-cholera virus having been outlawed in the state makes the issuance of permits for the administering of such virus obsolete.
