A BILL FOR

An Act to make deficiency appropriations for various state departments for the biennium ending June 30, 1965. *motion to reconsider lost 5/26 (21-30)*

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state of Iowa to the state department of social welfare,
 3 the sum of three hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$320,000.00)
 4 for the biennium ending June 30, 1965, to be used for medical
 5 assistance to the aged as provided by chapter two hundred forty-
 6 nine A (249A), Code 1962.

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state of Iowa to the Iowa development commission, the sum
 3 of forty-one thousand five hundred dollars (\$41,500.00) for the
 4 biennium ending June 30, 1965, to be used in the following
 5 manner:

6 For salaries	\$23,593.00
7 For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
8 purposes	17,907.00
9 Total	<u>\$41,500.00</u>

1 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of
 2 the state of Iowa to the department of public safety, the sum of
 3 eighty-six thousand ninety-three dollars (\$86,093.00) for the
 4 biennium ending June 30, 1965, to be used in the following manner:

5	DIVISION OF HIGHWAY PATROL	
6	For salaries	\$43,863.00
7	For support, maintenance and miscellaneous	
8	purposes	42,230.00
9	Total	<u>\$86,093.00</u>

1 Sec. 4. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall
2 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
3 publication in the Fort Dodge Messenger, a newspaper published
4 in Fort Dodge, Iowa, and in the Algona-Kossuth County Advance,
5 a newspaper published in Algona, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 665

This bill is to provide funds out of the state general fund to meet the deficiency needs of the department of social welfare—medical assistance to the aged, the Iowa development commission, and the department of public safety—division of highway patrol.

The social welfare deficiency is a technical appropriation to carry out the intentions of the 60th General Assembly in the transfer, or allocation of a portion of the contingent fund in the amount of \$320,000. See section 3 of chapter 9, Acts of the 60th General Assembly.

The deficiency appropriation of the Iowa development commission relates to the continued upgrading of staff in light of the present industrial development in Iowa and the funds needed on the various "sell Iowa" tours.

The deficiency of the department of public safety relates to the immediacy of putting 50 new patrolmen on the road, the related schooling and equipment needs which were not contemplated in the original appropriation measure.
