A BILL FOR

An Act relating to fees for the chauffeur's and operator's
and for the instruction and temporary driver's permit.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point one
- 2 hundred ninety-one (321.191), Code 1962, is hereby repealed and
- 3 the following enacted in lieu thereof:

- 4 "The fee for an operator's license or a temporary driver's
- 5 permit shall be five (5) dollars. The fee for an instruction
- 6 permit shall be three (3) dollars. The fee for a chauffeur's
- 7 license shall be six (6) dollars."

- 1 Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance
- 2 shall take effect upon immediate publication and be in full force
- 3 and effect from and after its passage and publication in The
- 4 Times-Democrat, a newspaper published at Davenport, Iowa, and
- 5 in the Council Bluffs Nonpareil, a newspaper published at
- 6 Council Bluffs, Iowa, all without expense to the State of Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 67

The State of Iowa is considering a comprehensive traffic safety program to increase the size of the Iowa Highway Patrol, provide driver education to all young people in the state, and establish a periodic re-examination of all drivers. The total cost of this program is nearly \$5,000,000 per biennium. Logically, Iowa motorists will benefit most from this program, and they should be the ones to pay the greater share. A reasonable increase in fees as proposed in this bill will raise a substantial proportion of the total cost of the program and will not put the Iowa fees out of line with what other states are now charging or asking to be charged.
