A BILL FOR

An Act to authorize the state conservation commission to use monies appropriated by chapter twenty-four (24), section two (2), Acts of the Fifty-ninth General Assembly.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The conservation commission is hereby authorized
2 to extend to June 30, 1967, the appropriation in the amount of
3 twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00), or so much thereof as is
4 necessary, appropriated by chapter twenty-four (24), section two
5 (2), lines ninety-two (92) and ninety-three (93), Acts of the
6 Fifty-ninth General Assembly, for the purpose of land acquisition
7 at Swan Lake state park.

1 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall
2 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publi-
3 cation in the Algona Kossuth County Advance, a newspaper published
4 at Algona, Iowa, and the Carroll Daily Times Herald, a newspaper
5 published at Carroll, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 691

The purpose of this bill is to extend the time on an appropriation that was made by the 59th General Assembly of \$20,000 for land acquisition for Swan Lake State park. The state was unable to use this because the amount was too small to buy parcels of land. The situation has changed due to federal funds and possible state funds. This amount can now be utilized.
