A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, to the state board of regents for the salaries, support, maintenance, equipment, miscellaneous purposes and repairs, replacements and alterations of institutions under the said state board of regents.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
- 2 of the state for each year of the biennium beginning July 1,
- 3 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, for salaries, support, maintenance,
- 4 equipment, miscellaneous purposes and repairs, replacements and
- 5 alterations for all institutions under the control of the state
- 6 board of regents, the following sums or so much thereof as may
- 7 be necessary for the following purposes to wit:

STATE UNIVERSITY OF IOWA

Iowa City

- 1 Sec. 2. For the state university of Iowa there is hereby
- 2 appropriated from the general fund of the state for each year of
- 3 the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, the
- 4 following sum or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used
- 5 in the following manner:

- 6 For salaries, support, maintenance,
- 7 equipment, miscellaneous; and repairs,
- 8 replacements and alterations for the
- 9 state university of Iowa\$20,953,613.00

LAKESIDE LABORATORY

1 Sec. 3. For the lakeside laboratory there is hereby appro-
2 priated from the general fund of the state for each year of the
3 biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, the
4 following sum or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used
5 in the following manner:

6 For repairs, replacements and alterations
7 for the lakeside laboratory\$ 7,997.00

UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL

1 Sec. 4. For the purpose of carrying out the purpose of chapter
2 two hundred fifty-five (255), Code 1962, there is hereby appro-
3 priated from the general fund of the state for each year of the
4 biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, the
5 following sum or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used
6 in the following manner:

7 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment,
8 miscellaneous; and for medical surgical treatment
9 of indigent patients; and for repairs, replacements
10 and alterations for the university hospital\$ 7,620,644.00

PSYCHOPATHIC HOSPITAL

1 Sec. 5. For the psychopathic hospital for the purpose of
2 chapter two hundred twenty-five (225), Code 1962, there is hereby
3 appropriated from the general fund of the state for each year of
4 the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967,
5 the following sum or so much thereof as may be necessary to be
6 used in the following manner:

7 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment,
8 miscellaneous; and for the care, treatment and

9 maintenance of committed and voluntary public
 10 patients therein; and for repairs, replacements
 11 and alterations for the psychopathic hospital\$ 1,652,516.00

BACTERIOLOGICAL LABORATORY

1 Sec. 6. For the bacteriological laboratory there is hereby
 2 appropriated from the general fund of the state for each year
 3 of the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967,
 4 the following sum or so much thereof as may be necessary to be
 5 used in the manner and under the authority provided in chapter
 6 two hundred sixty-three (263), Code 1962:
 7 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment
 8 and miscellaneous purposes for the bacteriological
 9 laboratory\$ 519,504.00

HOSPITAL SCHOOL

1 Sec. 7. For the hospital school there is hereby appropriated
 2 from the general fund of the state for each year of the biennium
 3 beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, the following
 4 sum or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used in the
 5 manner and under the authority provided in chapter two hundred
 6 sixty-three (263), Code 1962:
 7 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment,
 8 miscellaneous; and for repairs, replacements and
 9 alterations for the hospital school\$ 1,010,155.00

IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Ames

1 Sec. 8. For the Iowa state university of science and technology,
 2 there is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state
 3 for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending

4 June 30, 1967, the following sum or so much thereof as may be
5 necessary to be used in the following manner:

6 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment,
7 miscellaneous; and repairs, replacements, and
8 alterations for the Iowa state university of
9 science and technology\$16,278,866.00

IOWA AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT STATION

1 Sec. 9. For the Iowa agricultural experiment station, there is
2 hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state for each
3 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30,
4 1967, the following sum or so much thereof as may be necessary
5 to be used in the following manner:

6 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment
7 and miscellaneous purposes for the Iowa
8 agricultural experiment station\$ 2,916,364.00

CO-OPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE IN AGRICULTURE AND
HOME ECONOMICS

1 Sec. 10. For the co-operative extension service in agriculture
2 and home economics there is hereby appropriated from the general
3 fund of the state for each year of the biennium beginning July 1,
4 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, the following sum or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary to be used in the following manner:

6 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment
7 and miscellaneous purposes for the co-operative
8 extension service in agriculture and home
9 economics\$ 2,047,840.00

STATE COLLEGE OF IOWA

Cedar Falls

1 Sec. 11. For the state college of Iowa there is hereby appro-

2 appropriated from the general fund of the state for each year of the
 3 biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, the
 4 following sum or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used
 5 in the following manner:

6 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment,
 7 miscellaneous; and repairs, replacements and
 8 alterations for the state college of Iowa\$ 6,170,719.00

IOWA BRAILLE AND SIGHT SAVING SCHOOL

Vinton

1 Sec. 12. For the Iowa braille and sight saving school there
 2 is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state for
 3 each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending
 4 June 30, 1967, the following sum or so much thereof as may be
 5 necessary to be used in the following manner:

6 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment,
 7 miscellaneous; and repairs, replacements and
 8 alterations for the Iowa braille and sight
 9 saving school\$ 563,956.00

IOWA SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF

Council Bluffs

1 Sec. 13. For the Iowa school for the deaf there is hereby
 2 appropriated from the general fund of the state for each year of
 3 the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, the
 4 following sum or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used
 5 in the following manner:

6 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment,
 7 miscellaneous; and repairs, replacements and
 8 alterations for the Iowa school for the deaf\$ 1,009,020.00

STATE SANATORIUM

Oakdale

1 Sec. 14. For the state sanatorium there is hereby appropriated
 2 from the general fund of the state for each year of the biennium
 3 beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, the following
 4 sum or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used in the
 5 following manner:

6 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment,
 7 miscellaneous; and repairs, replacements and
 8 alterations for the state sanatorium\$ 1,248,786.00
 9 Total of the appropriations for the institutions
 10 under the state board of regents for all purposes\$62,000,000.00

11 Sec. 15. The budget of total expenditures for each institution
 12 under the control of the state board of regents, including state
 13 appropriations and such other receipts as may be available for
 14 the same purpose as the state appropriations, during the biennium
 15 shall not exceed the budget for each institution as hereinafter
 16 set forth, except the state board of regents may, in the event
 17 of an emergency or necessity, which may arise at any particular
 18 institution under its control, expend more than the amount
 19 budgeted for such institution which expenditure shall be made
 20 out of increase in receipts of such institution, such increase
 21 in receipts meaning receipts in excess of the estimation of re-
 22 ceipts of the respective institutions set forth in the appropria-
 23 tions proposals submitted to the general assembly, provided that
 24 thirty days prior to such proposed increased expenditure the board
 25 shall report in writing to the state comptroller the specific
 26 purpose of such additional expenditure and the source and amount

17 of funds available therefor, and further said board shall set out
 18 in its biennial report to the governor and the next general assembly
 19 such increased expenditures, the purpose thereof, and the source
 20 and amount of funds used therefor.

21 No funds appropriated by this Act or receipts, which may be
 22 used for the same purpose as said appropriations, may be used for
 23 capital improvements.

1 Sec. 16. All salaries provided for in this Act shall be payable
 2 in equal monthly or semi-monthly installments, and shall be in
 3 full compensation for all services except as otherwise expressly
 4 provided and except further that expense allowances shall be

5 authorized, any ruling of the Federal Internal Revenue Service
6 with respect to the tax status thereof notwithstanding.

1 Sec. 17. Chapter eight (8), Code 1962, shall apply to this
2 Act, except that employees whose salaries are appropriated herein
3 shall not come under the division of personnel under section
4 eight point five (8.5), Code 1962.

HOUSE FILE 706

1 Amend House File 706 by adding thereto the following new
2 sections:

3 1. "The state board of regents is hereby directed to under-
4 take a study and outline plans for the establishment, construction,
5 and operation of a state institution of higher learning in western
6 Iowa. Upon the effective date of this Act, the state board of
7 regents shall proceed to obtain and compile such information and
8 data as shall be necessary to determine the most convenient, desir-
9 able, and advantageous location for a state institution of higher
10 learning in western Iowa."

11 2. "In determining the location of the state institution of
12 higher learning in western Iowa, the state board of regents shall
13 collect data in regard to the need for the institution and the number
14 of students which the institution can serve most adequately. The
15 board shall contact various communities throughout western Iowa in
16 an attempt to determine which communities are most interested in
17 being considered as a possible site for the institution, which com-
18 munities have the most desirable educational climate for the insti-
19 tution, and which communities will not only serve western Iowa as
20 a center for educational progress but will most adequately provide
21 an educational center for the state as a whole."

22 3. "Upon selection of the location, the state board shall
23 purchase, acquire, lease, or accept as a gift any real property
24 necessary for the establishment of the school. Any real estate so
25 obtained shall be acquired to most economically and efficiently
26 facilitate the establishment and growth of the educational insti-
27 tution."

28 4. "There is hereby appropriated to the state board of regents
29 from the general fund of the state of Iowa the sum of one hundred
30 thousand (100,00) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
31 to be used to carry out the study, planning, and establishment of
32 the institution of higher education to be established in western
33 Iowa. The state board may employ such staff, architects, attorneys,
34 and other professional help necessary to conduct the study and to
35 acquire real property and for such other purposes as the board
36 deems necessary. Salaries of all staff so employed shall be paid
37 from the appropriation provided herein."
