A BILL FOR

An Act enabling the governor to mobilize the executive department of the state in the event of an emergency on the public highways.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter seven (7), Code 1962, is hereby amended

2 by adding the following new section:

3 "Whenever the governor is satisfied that a state of emergency

4 exists, or is likely to exist, on the public streets or highways

5 of this state, because of violations of chapter three hundred

6 twenty-one (321) of the code, he shall designate any employee

7 or employees of this state as peace officers pursuant to

8 section seven hundred forty-eight point three subsection five

9 (748.3 (5) of the code, until such time as the governor is

10 satisfied the state of emergency is ended.

1 Sec. 2. Individuals so designated shall have the full duties

2 and rights of peace officers under the code, and shall be provided

3 with and identifying badge and card.

1 Sec. 3. The governor, in exercising the power conferred

2 upon him by this Act, may designate one employee or officer

3 of the state to supervise all persons designated as peace

4 officers hereunder, and they shall be fully responsible to him

5 for all acts performed pursuant to this Act.

1 Sec. 4. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall

2 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
 3 publication in the _____, a newspaper
 4 published at _____, Iowa, and in the _____
 5 _____, a newspaper published at _____
 6 Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 714

This bill would give the governor, when satisfied that an emergency exists or is likely to exist on Iowa public streets or highways because of violations of chapter 321 (Motor Vehicles and Laws of the Road), authority to designate state employees as peace officers.

 3 "for the purpose of enforcing the motor vehicle laws and ordi-
 4 nances of this state."

 5 shall be compensated at the rate of one and one-half (1½) times
 6 their regular pay and shall be paid from funds of the public
 7 safety department. In lieu of said compensation, said employees
 8 may be given time off at the rate of one and one-half (1½) days
 9 for each day of such employment."
 10 2. By renumbering the remaining sections in accordance with
 11 this amendment.
