## A BILL FOR

An Act making appropriations for payment of miscellaneous expense incurred or authorized by the Sixty-first General Assembly.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds in  
2 the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the following sums,  
3 or so much thereof as may be necessary, in payment of miscellan-  
4 eous expenses incurred or authorized by the Sixty-first General  
5 Assembly:

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund a  
2 sum sufficient to pay the compensation made necessary by Senate  
3 Concurrent Resolution 46 for services required of officers and  
4 employees of the Sixty-first General Assembly after final adjourn-  
5 ment, and prior to the convening of the Sixty-second General  
6 Assembly, including any special session called during such period.

1 Sec. 3. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to make  
2 available any unexpended balance of the appropriation of eight  
3 thousand five hundred dollars (\$8,500.00) made to the executive  
4 council in chapter fifty-four, Acts of the Sixtieth General  
5 Assembly, for legislative expenses in order that such balance may  
6 be applied to the payment of legislative expenses of the Sixty-  
7 first General Assembly.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 718

This bill is the omnibus bill and appropriates for miscellaneous items.

HOUSE FILE 718

2 ing after the period in line 16: "Miscellaneous expenses,
