A BILL FOR

An Act to permit specially qualified high school students to attend a college or university for advanced courses and to pay tuition therefor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. The board of any school district may, by mutual
- 2 agreement with any college or university, permit any
- 3 specially qualified high school student to attend advanced
- 4 courses of instruction therein and to pay to said college
- 5 or university tuition agreed upon from the funds of the
- 6 school corporation. The state board of regents may by rule
- 7 permit such students to attend any institution of higher
- 8 learning under their jurisdiction. Credit earned in any
- 9 such course at a college or university may be applied toward
- 10 credit for high school graduation.
