# A BILL FOR

*passed senate as amended 5/2 (55-0)*

An Act relating to powers of electors to vote a school house tax.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred seventy-eight point one (278.1),
- 2 subsection seven (7), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding the
- 3 following new sentence thereto:

“The power to levy said tax, when voted, shall continue for

5 such period of time as may be authorized by the voters and shall

6 not be affected by any change in the boundaries of the school

7 district, in whatever manner effect, except in case the school

8 district is reorganized pursuant to sections two hundred seventy-

9 five point twelve (275.12) and two hundred seventy-five point

10 twenty-three (275.23), both inclusive.”
