A BILL FOR

An Act relating to establishing time for the state of Iowa.

Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. The standard time in this state shall be the solar
 time of the ninetieth (90th) meridian of longitude west of
 Greenwich, commonly known as central standard time, except from
 two (2) o'clock ante meridiem of Memorial Day in every year and
 until two (2) o'clock ante meridiem of the day following Labor Day
 in the same year, standard time shall be advanced one (1) hour.
 The period of time so advanced shall be known as "daylight saving
 time".

Sec. 2. In all laws, statutes, orders, decrees, rules, and
 regulations relating to the time of performance of any act by any
 officer or department of this state, including the legislative,
 executive, and judicial branches of the state government, or any
 county, city, town, or district thereof, relating to the time in
 which any rights shall accrue or determine, or within which any
 act shall or shall not be performed by any person subject to the
 jurisdiction of this state and in all the public schools and insti-
 tutions of this state, or of any county, city, town, or district
 thereof, and in all contracts and choses in action made or to be
 performed in this state, the time shall be the time established
 in section one (1) of this Act.
