# A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the safety of persons performing maintenance and construction work on highways.

*Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Chapter three hundred twenty-one (321), Code 1962,

2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 1. "Every driver of a vehicle shall yield the right of way to

4 persons engaged in maintenance or construction work on a highway

5 whenever the driver is notified of the presence of the workers

6 by flagman, warning sign, or any other manner of warning."
