# A BILL FOR

An Act to provide for the continuation of Iowa's Plan to Combat Mental Retardation and making an appropriation therefor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. The board of control of state institutions is
- 2 hereby designated as the single state agency to act as the
- 3 administrative agency to provide for the continuation of
- 4 comprehensive planning to combat mental retardation.
- 1 Section 2. The board shall employ the staff necessary for
- 2 the purposes of interpretation, evaluation, and dissemination
- 3 of Iowa's Comprehensive Plan to Combat Mental Retardation and
- 4 to carry on needed research.
- 1 Section 3. The board is authorized and empowered to apply
- 2 for and receive federal aids, grants, and gifts for purposes
- 3 relating to mental retardation.
- 1 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from the general
- 2 fund of the state of Iowa for the Iowa board of control of
- 3 state institutions the sum of thirty thousand (\$30,000) dollars
- 4 for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending
- 5 June 30, 1967, or so much thereof as may be necessary.
