# A BILL FOR

An Act to permit use of box traps in trapping cottontail rabbits and squirrels.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred nine point ninety-two (109.92),
- 2 Code of 1962, is hereby amended by inserting, following the word
- 3 "animals" in line six (6), the following: "except cottontail
- 4 rabbits and squirrels. Box traps capable of capturing more than
- 5 one (1) rabbit or one (1) squirrel at each setting are prohibited.
- 6 A valid hunting license is required for box trapping except as
- 7 otherwise provided. All box traps shall have a metal tag attached
- 8 plainly labeled with the owner's name and address. Conservation
- 9 officers shall have authority to confiscate such traps when found
- 10 in use that are not properly labeled."
