A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the licensing and qualifications of physical therapists.

It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SENATE FILE 275 (Committee Amendment)

- 1 Amend Senate File 275 as follows:
- 2 1. Amend section one (1), line seven (7) by adding
- 3 after the word "surgeon" the words "or chiropractor".
- 4 2. Amend section three (3) by striking all of para-
- 5 graph one (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 6 "Persons licensed to practice any of the professions
- 7 specified in section 146.4 may advise concerning diet and
- 8 nutritional supplements and use physical rehabilitation
- 9 procedures under their own direction and incidental to
- 10 their practice of their respective professions. So doing
- 11 shall not be construed as violation of any of the sections,
- 12 chapters or provisions of this Title."
- 13 3. Amend section three (3), paragraph four (4) by
- 14 adding the words "or chiropractor" after the word "surgeon"
- 15 in line eighteen (18).

- 8 following:
- 9 "3. Assist in the advancement of the arts and sciences of
- 10 physical therapy. In no event shall any part of such expense be
- 11 paid out of the state treasury. Any remainder in said fund at
- 12 the end of each fiscal year shall be paid into the general fund of
- 13 the state. Said fund shall be subject at all times to the warrant
- 14 of the state comptroller drawn upon written requisition of the chair-
- 15 man of the examining board and attested by the secretary, for the
- 16 payment of all salaries, per diem expense, and other expenses
- 17 necessary to administer and aid in the enforcement of the
- 18 provisions of law relating to the practice of physical therapy,
- 19 but in no event shall the total expenses therefor exceed the total
- 20 fees collected and deposited to the credit of said fund."
