A BILL FOR

An Act to legalize the proceedings of the board of supervisors of Linn county in connection with a contract made with Loomis Bros., Inc. of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, for remodeling of two (2) court rooms in the Linn county courthouse located in Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

WHEREAS, on March 10, 1964 the records show that the Linn county board of supervisors enacted into a contract with Loomis Bros., Inc. of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, to remodel two (2) court rooms in the Linn county courthouse located in Cedar Rapids, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, the contract price agreed upon of four thousand nine hundred ninety-eight (4,998) dollars was consummated contrary to section three hundred thirty-two point seven (332.7), Code 1962; and

WHEREAS, the work was completed in June of 1964 and such was accepted by the Linn county board of supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the legality of such contract has been questioned thereby causing payment to be denied Loomis Bros., Inc. of Cedar Rapids, Iowa; NOW THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. All proceedings heretofore taken by the board of
 2 supervisors of Linn county in connection with and pertaining to
 3 the completion of the contract entered into by the said board of
 4 supervisors with Loomis Bros., Inc. of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, for
 5 the remodeling of two (2) court rooms in the Linn county court-
 6 house located in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, are hereby declared to be
 7 legal and to constitute a valid and binding obligation of Linn
 8 county.

1 Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall
 2 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publi-
 3 cation in Central City Newsletter, a newspaper published at

- 4 Central City, Iowa, and The Marion Sentinel,
- 5 a newspaper published at Marion, Iowa, without expense
- 6 to the state.
