# A BILL FOR

An Act relating to solicitation from liquor control licensees.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred fourteen (114), Acts of the
- 2 Sixtieth General Assembly is hereby amended as follows:
- 3 1. By inserting in line two hundred thirty-seven (237) after
- 4 the word "gratuities," the word "political".
- 5 2. By adding to section ten (10) the following new subsection:
- 6 "It shall be unlawful for any individual who is seeking public
- 7 office to accept or solicit donations, gratuities, political ad-
- 8 vertising, gifts, or other favors directly or indirectly from any
- 9 licensee hereunder. For the purpose of this subsection a person
- 10 is considered to be seeking public office from the date of filing
- 11 nomination papers or announcing his intention to run for office
- 12 whichever occurs first to the date that the individual who is
- 13 elected officially takes office. Anyone violating this section
- 14 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be
- 15 punished as provided in subsection twelve (12) of this section."
