**A BILL FOR**

An Act relating to the powers and duties of the State Board for Vocational Education, Division of Vocational Rehabilitation.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred fifty-nine point four (259.4),

2 Code 1962, is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By adding a new sub-section nineteen (19).

4 "Provide financial and other necessary assistance to public,  
5 or non-sectarian private agencies in the development, expansion,  
6 operation or maintenance of sheltered workshops or other  
7 rehabilitation facilities needed for the rehabilitation of the  
8 disabled when consistent with the policies of the board."

9 2. By adding a new sub-section twenty (20).

10 "Provide vocational rehabilitation services to socially  
11 disadvantaged persons who are substantially impaired in their  
12 ability to earn a living. This may include but is not limited to  
13 recipients of public assistance, inmates of correctional  
14 institutions or rejectees of the selective service system, who  
15 because of lack of training, experience, skills or other factors,  
16 which if corrected would lead to self-support instead of  
17 dependency."
