# A BILL FOR

*Judiciary 2/12 "Do Pass" 2/93*

An Act to legalize and validate the proceedings in which the School Board of the South Hamilton Community School District, approved a 1-mill levy to be added to the School House Fund for school site in the 1962-63 school budget, and declaring the proceedings of said School Board to be legalized.

WHEREAS, it appears from the records of the Board of Directors of the South Hamilton Community School District, in the County of Hamilton, State Iowa, that on or about July 9, 1962, the School Board of the South Hamilton Community School District approved a 1-mill levy to be added to the School House Fund for school site and thereafter realized \$15,468.29 from the said 1-mill levy, and

WHEREAS, the South Hamilton Community School District does not have a city within the district of two thousand population or more, and

WHEREAS, doubts have arisen concerning the validity and legal sufficiency of said 1-mill levy and collection of said tax to be added to the School House Fund for school site and it is deemed advisable to put such doubts and all others that might arise concerning same forever at rest; NOW, THEREFORE,

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. That all proceedings heretofore taken by
- 2 the Board of Directors of the South Hamilton Community School
- 3 District, in the County of Hamilton, State of Iowa, preliminary
- 4 to and in connection with the approval and authorization of a
- 5 1-mill levy to be added to the School House Fund for school
- 6 site and the resulting collection of \$15,468.29 pursuant
- 7 thereto, are hereby legalized, validated and confirmed and
- 8 said proceedings and collection are hereby declared to be
- 9 legal and legally added to the School House Fund for school
- 10 site in said district.

1    Sec. 2. This Act being of immediate importance shall  
2    be in full force and effect from and after its passage and  
3    publication in the Jewell Record, a newspaper published at  
4    Jewell, Iowa, and in the Ellsworth News, a newspaper published  
5    at Ellsworth, Iowa, without expense to the state.
