A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the deduction from salaries or wages of state officers and employees of amounts of money designated by them for payment to the United Fund or other similar organization.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. As used in this Act "United Fund" means the
 2 organization conducting the single, annual, consolidated ef-
 3 fort to secure funds for distribution to agencies engaged in
 4 charitable and public health, welfare and service purposes,
 5 which commonly is known as the United Fund, or the United
 6 Campaign, United Community Services, Community Chest or other
 7 organization which serves in place of the United Fund organi-
 8 zation in communities where an organization known as the
 9 United Fund is not organized.

1 Sec. 2. The State Comptroller may, upon written request
 2 of a state officer or employee, deduct each regular payroll
 3 period from the salary or wages of the officer or employee
 4 the amount specified therein for payment to the united fund.
 5 The moneys so deducted shall be paid over promptly to the
 6 united fund designated by the officer or employee. Such de-
 7 ductions may be made notwithstanding that the compensation
 8 paid in cash to such officer or employee is thereby reduced
 9 below the minimum prescribed by law. Payment to such officer
 10 or employee of compensation less such deduction shall consti-

- 11 tute a full and complete discharge and acquittance of all
- 12 claims and demands whatsoever for the services rendered by
- 13 such employee during the period covered by such payment.
- 14 Such request for deduction may be withdrawn at any time by
- 15 filing a written notification of withdrawal with the State
- 16 Comptroller.

- 1 Amend Senate File 386 as follows:
- 2 1. By striking the period (.) after the word "organization" in
- 3 line four (4) of the title and adding the following: "and to
- 4 authorize school district employees to have the same deductions
- 5 to the United Fund or other similar organizations, together
- 6 with deductions by school district employees for dues to
- 7 professional associations and employee organizations."
- 8 2. By adding the following as section 3:
- 9 Sec. 3. Section two hundred seventy-nine point twenty-
- 10 seven (279.27), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting in
- 11 line eighteen (18) after the period, the following: 'An
- 12 employee may authorize a deduction from his salary for
- 13 contributions to United Funds or other similar organizations
- 14 and for dues to a professional association and employee
- 15 organization and if the same be so authorized in writing by
- 16 such employee and filed with the secretary of the board the
- 17 same shall be so withheld and deducted from such employee's
- 18 salary and paid by the secretary to such association or
- 19 organization until otherwise notified in writing by such
- 20 employee.'
