Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred sixty-two point nine (262.9),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection:
- 3 "Grant leaves of absence with full or partial compensation to
- 4 staff members to undertake approved programs of study, research,
- 5 or other professional activity which in the judgment of the board
- 6 will contribute to the improvement of the institutions."
