A BILL FOR

motion to reconsider tabled 7/19
passed Senate as amended 7/28 (47-2) 1/19
An Act relating to the issuance of a temporary driver's permit.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point one hundred
2 eighty-one (321.181), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following:

4 "Any person on first application for a license to operate a
5 motor vehicle, except for a school license, who meets the require-
6 ments of section three hundred twenty-one point one hundred
7 eighty-six (321.186), Code 1962, shall be issued a temporary
8 driver's permit for a period not to exceed one year. The permit
9 shall be cancelled upon the conviction for a moving traffic viola-
10 tion and reapplication may be made thirty (30) days after the date
11 of cancellation.

1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twenty-one point one hundred
2 eighty-two (321.182), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding to
3 line two (2) after the word "license", the words "or temporary
4 driver's permit".

4 Sec. 3. The cancellation of the temporary driver's
5 permit upon conviction for a moving traffic violation
6 shall not result in requiring the applicant to maintain
7 proof of financial responsibility under section three
8 hundred twenty-one A point seventeen (321A.17), unless
9 the conviction would otherwise result in a suspension
10 or revocation of the person's driver's license.

1 Amend Senate File 422 by striking all after the enacting clause
2 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
3 "Section 1. Chapter three hundred twenty-one (321), Code 1954,
4 is hereby amended by adding the following new section:
5 1. In addition to any grounds for suspension or revocation
6 of motor vehicle operator's licenses, chauffeur's licenses and
7 driving privileges stated in any other provision of law, the
8 department may suspend the driver's license, chauffeur's license
9 or driving privilege held by any person under eighteen (18) years
10 of age upon receiving satisfactory evidence that the licensee has
11 been involved in two (2) or more accidents chargeable to such
12 licensee.
13 2. The department shall suspend or revoke, as hereinafter
14 provided, the driver's license, chauffeur's license or driving
15 privilege held by any person under eighteen (18) years of age
16 upon receiving a record that such licensee has been convicted
17 of violating any law of this state or city ordinance, other than
18 parking regulations, regulating the operation of motor vehicles
19 on the highways.
20 For the first (1st) such conviction the department shall sus-
21 pend such licenses or driving privilege for a period of fifteen
22 (15) days.
23 For the second (2nd) such conviction the department shall
24 suspend such licenses or driving privilege for a period of ninety
25 (90) days.
26 For the third (3rd) such conviction the department shall
27 revoke such licenses or driving privilege and the licensee
28 shall not be issued any operator's license, chauffeur's license
29 or driving privilege until he has reached the age of eighteen
30 (18) or until a period of one (1) year shall have elapsed since
31 such conviction, whichever shall be the later."
32 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twenty-one point one hundred
33 ninety-four (321.194), Code 1954, is hereby amended by striking
34 all of such section after the word, "department" in line thirty-
35 eight (38) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
36 "shall suspend or revoke, as provided in this chapter, such license
37 upon receiving satisfactory evidence that the licensee has violated
38 the restrictions of such license."
39 Further amend the title by striking all after the word "Act"
40 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
41 "relating to the suspension and revocation of a motor vehicle
42 operator's license, chauffeur's license and driving privilege of
43 persons under the age of eighteen (18)."
