Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Amend section seven hundred sixty-nine point
2 eighteen (769.18), Code 1962, by adding the following sentence at
3 the end thereof: "After preliminary information, indictment, or
4 information the defendant shall be present and have the opportunity
5 to cross-examine any witnesses whose appearance before the
6 county attorney is required by this section.

1 Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
