Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Motion to reconsider filed 5/26

- 1 Section 1. Section ten (10) of chapter one hundred
- 2 fourteen (114), Acts of the Sixtieth (60th) General Assembly
- 3 is amended by adding after the period (.) in line two hundred
- 4 twenty-nine (229) the following:
- 5 "Provided, however, the commission is authorized to issue
- 6 six-month (6) or eight-month (8) seasonal licenses for a pro-
- 7 portionate part of the license fee hereinafter specified. No
- 8 refund shall be made for seasonal licenses. No seasonal li-
- 9 cense shall be renewed except after a period of two (2) months."

1 Amend Senate File 441 by adding the following:
 2 "Section 2. Chapter one hundred twenty-three (123), Code
 3 1962, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
 4 following new section:
 5 "The commission with approval of the local issuing authorities
 6 under such regulations as it shall promulgate may issue special
 7 occasion permits for the sale and consumption of alcoholic
 8 liquor at a specified location by any local, district or state
 9 unit of a veterans organization chartered by the Congress of
 10 the United States, to the auditorium commission or auditorium
 11 trustees for auditoriums as contemplated in chapter thirty-
 12 seven (37) and three hundred seventy-four A (374A) of the Code,
 13 hotels, or restaurants with private facilities, upon the follow-
 14 ing terms and conditions:
 15 1. That such applicant remit with its application the sum
 16 of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) as a permit fee in lieu of
 17 license and tax on such sales as may be made.
 18 2. That such permit be valid for a period of not more than
 19 fifteen (15) hours during any one (1) day.
 20 3. That the premises designated by such permit be approved
 21 by the commission under such regulations as the commission may
 22 adopt.

1 Amend Senate File 441 by adding thereto the following sections:
 2 "Sec. 2. Section sixteen (16) of chapter one hundred fourteen
 3 (114), Acts of the Sixtieth General Assembly, is hereby further
 4 amended by inserting after line forty-three (43) the following
 5 paragraph:
 6 'Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph b of this subsection,
 7 the holder of a liquor control license may lease the licensed
 8 premises on Sunday to a private party or parties provided he has
 9 first secured permission from the commission and the local law
 10 enforcement authority. Liquor shall not be sold by either the
 11 lessor or lessee, but the lessee may serve liquor gratuitously
 12 to his guests during the period covered by the rental agreement.
 13 The lessee shall not purchase liquor from the lessor, but shall
 14 transfer his own liquor to the premises to serve his guests gratui-
 15 tously. Any person violating the provisions of this paragraph
 16 shall be termed a bootlegger under the provisions of section one
 17 hundred twenty-three point fifty-nine (123.59) of the Code and
 18 shall be punished as provided therein.'
 19 "Sec. 3. Section thirty (30) of chapter one hundred fourteen
 20 (114), Acts of the Sixtieth General Assembly, is amended by in-
 21 serting in line thirteen (13) after the word 'place' the words
 22 'or premises leased by a liquor control license holder to a
 23 private party under the provisions of section one hundred twenty-
 24 three point forty-six (123.46) of the Code.'
 25 Further amend the title by inserting after the word "licenses"
 26 the words "and the serving of liquor on licensed premises".
