A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the testing of infants for phenylketonuria.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred thirty-five (135), Code 1962,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section:
- 3 "It is hereby declared to be the policy of this state that
- 4 every infant born within the borders of Iowa shall, insofar as
- 5 practicable, be tested for the presence of the disease known as
- 6 phenylketonuria within a reasonable period following birth. It
- 7 shall be the responsibility of the state department of health
- 8 to implement this policy at such time and with such rules and
- 9 regulations as the commissioner of public health deems advisable."

- 2 period in line 9: "All state, county, and city health or welfare
- 3 agencies shall cooperate and participate in the implementation
- 4 of this Act and such rules and regulations, when requested by
- 5 the commissioner of public health."
