A BILL FOR

An Act relating to suspension or cancellation of liquor control licenses.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section thirteen (13) of chapter one hundred
- 2 fourteen (114), Acts 60th General Assembly is hereby repealed
- 3 and the following enacted in lieu thereof:
 - 1 "Sec. 13. Chapter one hundred twenty-three (123), Code 1962,
 - 2 is amended by adding the following new section:
 - 3 'Any liquor control license issued under this chapter may,
 - 4 after notice in writing to the license holder and reasonable
 - 5 opportunity for hearing, be suspended or canceled by the issuing
 - 6 authority or the commission for any of the following causes:
 - 7 a. Misrepresentation of any material fact in the appli-
 - 8 cation for such license, or
 - 9 b. Violation of any of the provisions of this chapter as
 - 10 amended or regulations of the commission, or
 - 11 c. Any change in the ownership or interest in the busi-
 - 12 ness operated under a class "A", class "B", or class "C" license,
 - 13 which change was not previously reported to the commission and
 - 14 approved by it, or
 - 15 d. An event which would have resulted in disqualification
 - 16 from receiving such license when originally issued, or
 - 17 e. Any sale, hypothecation, or transfer of such license.
 - 18 f. Any liquor control licensee whose license is revoked

19 or canceled for cause shall not thereafter be permitted to hold
20 a liquor control license in the state of Iowa. The spouse and
21 business associates of a person whose license has been canceled
22 or revoked for cause shall not be issued a liquor control li-
23 cense, and no liquor control license shall be issued which covers
24 any business in which such person has a financial interest. In
25 the event a license is revoked for cause the premises covered
26 by a revoked license shall not be relicensed for one year."
