A BILL FOR

An Act authorizing the governor to accept federal funds.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Amend chapter seven (7), Code 1962, by adding
2 the following new section:

3 The governor is authorized to accept for the state the provi-
4 sions of any act of congress whereby funds or other benefits are
5 made availab'le to the state, its political subdivisions, or its citizens,
6 so far as the governor may deem such provisions to be in the public
7 interest; and to this end the governor may take or cause to be taken
8 all necessary acts including (without limitation because of enumera-
9 tion) the making of leases or other contracts with the federal govern-
10 ment; the preparation, adoption and execution of plans, methods, and
11 agreements, and the designation of state, municipal or other agencies
12 to perform specific duties.

1 Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall
2 take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the
3 Highland Park News, a newspaper published at Des Moines,
4 Iowa, and The West Des Moines Express, a news-
5 paper published at West Des Moines, Iowa.

1 Amend Senate File 540, section 1, by striking all of
2 lines 3 through 12 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
3 "The governor is authorized to accept for the state, the
4 funds provided by any act of congress for the benefit of the
5 State of Iowa, or its political subdivisions, provided there
6 is no agency to accept and administer such funds, and he is
7 authorized to administer or designate an agency to administer
8 the funds until such time as an agency of the state is
9 established for that purpose."
