## A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to the legislative members of the interim Commercial Code Study Committee and for supervision and preparation of proposed legislation for said committee.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general  
2 fund of the state of Iowa to the following named persons, as  
3 legislative members of the interim Commercial Code Study Com-  
4 mittee, and to Wayne Faupel for not to exceed fourteen days  
5 supervision and preparation of proposed legislation for said  
6 committee, the sum of thirty dollars for each of said persons  
7 for each day of such service, to wit:

8 Kenneth Benda, John J. Brown, Jacob Grimstead, John Mowry,  
9 Charles Frazier, Scott Swisher and David Stanley.

1 Sec. 2. The above named persons shall certify to the state  
2 comptroller the actual number of days for which such compensa-  
3 tion is provided by this Act. The state comptroller is author-  
4 ized to issue his warrants to the above named persons for the  
5 amounts computed from said certified number of days, multiplied  
6 by the rate stated above, and the state treasurer is directed  
7 to pay the same from the general fund.

1 Sec. 3. The acceptance of said sums by the above named par-  
2 ties shall be in full settlement of all claims against the  
3 state of Iowa growing out of said service.

1 Sec. 4. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,

2 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-  
3 tion in The Atlantic News-Telegraph, a newspaper published in  
4 Atlantic, Iowa, and in the Fort Dodge Messenger, a newspaper  
5 published in Fort Dodge, Iowa.

1 Amend Senate File 558 by striking all after the enacting clause  
2 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3 "Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general  
4 fund of the State of Iowa to the following named persons the  
5 amounts set opposite their respective names in full settlement  
6 of all claims which they have against the State of Iowa on  
7 account of services rendered as a member of the legislative  
8 interim commercial code study committee:

16 "Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund  
17 of the State of Iowa to Wayne Faupel, the sum of four hundred  
18 twenty dollars (\$420.00), in full settlement of all claims for  
19 his supervision and preparation of proposed legislation of the  
20 legislative interim commercial code study committee.

21 "Sec. 3. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to issue  
22 his warrants to the above named parties in the amounts stated,  
23 and the treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same from the  
24 funds herein appropriated.

25 "Sec. 4. The acceptance of said sums by the above named parties  
26 shall be in full settlement of all claims against the State of  
27 Iowa growing out of the above described claims.

28 "Sec. 5. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall  
29 be in full force and effect from and after its publication in  
30 The Atlantic News-Telegraph, a newspaper published in Atlantic,  
31 Iowa, and in the Fort Dodge Messenger, a newspaper published in  
32 Fort Dodge, Iowa."
