A BILL FOR

An Act to provide for the erection and equipping of a new State Office Building to be erected on the capitol grounds as they now exist or may be extended and to make an appropriation.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. A new State Office Building is hereby authorized
- 2 to be constructed on the capitol grounds to be located as
- 3 provided in the report of the Capitol Planning Commission.
- 4 The Executive Council and the Legislative Advisory Committee,
- 5 hereinafter created, are authorized and empowered to employ
- 6 architects for the preparation of plans and specifications for
- 7 said building.
- 8 The Executive Council and Advisory Committee are empowered to
- 9 approve such plans or order such changes as they may deem
- 10 necessary and enter into contracts for the erection and equipping
- 11 said building. The total cost of said building and equipment
- 12 shall not exceed the sum of two million five hundred thousand
- 13 dollars which amount is hereby appropriated to the Executive
- 14 Council for said purposes. All contracts for the erection and
- 15 equipment of said building shall be let in accordance with
- 16 chapters nineteen (19) and seventy-three (73) of the Code.
- 1 Sec. 2. There is hereby created a Legislative Advisory Com-
- 2 mittee consisting of three members of the Senate and three mem-
- 3 bers of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the

4 respective presiding officers for the purpose of complying with
5 the purposes and intent of this Act. The terms of the members
6 of said committee shall expire thirty days after the convening
7 of the next General Assembly. Vacancies of said committee shall
8 be filled by the presiding officer making the original appointment.

1 Sec. 3. The Legislative Advisory Committee and the Executive
2 Council shall meet jointly on the second Monday in June, 1965,
3 for organization and for the purposes of this Act. Meetings
4 thereafter shall be as determined by a majority of the joint com-
5 mittee and council or on call by the chairman.

1 Sec. 4. Each member of the Legislative Advisory Committee
2 shall be entitled to his necessary expenses from the appropriation
3 made by this Act.

1 Sec. 5. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall
2 take effect and be in force from and after its publication in
3 _____, a newspaper published in _____, Iowa,
4 and in _____, a newspaper published in
5 _____, Iowa.
