A BILL FOR *appropriations 5/13*
pass 5/17

An Act to appropriate funds from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the conservation commission for construction, replacement, repairs, development and alterations to state parks and reserves, state forests and state waters, for dredging, artificial lake development, erosion control, stream and lake access, land acquisition, for siltation control, for boundary surveys, engineering services and authorizing the obtaining and acceptance of federal funds to the state to be used in connection with this appropriation and federal funds in addition thereto.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the state conserva-
2 tion commission from the general fund of the state of Iowa the
3 sum of two million seven hundred forty-five thousand two hundred
4 thirty dollars (\$2,745,230.00) for construction, replacement,
5 repairs, development and alterations to state parks and reserves,
6 state forests and state waters, for dredging, artificial lake
7 development, erosion control, stream and lake access, land
8 acquisition, for siltation control and for boundary surveys.

1 Sec. 2. Said sum shall be allocated in the following amounts:

2 STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION

3 (1) For natural lake dredging\$ 360,000.00

4 (2) For construction, replacement, repairs,

5 development and alterations to state parks

6 and reserves, state forests and state

7 waters, artificial lake development

8 erosion control, stream and lake access,

9	land acquisition, for siltation control,	
10	boundary surveys, engineering services	
11	and to supplement any prior appropriations	
12	for such items	2,385,230.00
13	Only funds for natural lake dredging, boundary	
14	surveys and engineering services, may be used for	
15	salaries, support and maintenance.	
16	Grand total	\$2,745,230.00

1 Sec. 3. The state conservation commission, the governor and
 2 the state comptroller are hereby authorized to obtain and accept
 3 federal grants to the state to be used in connection with the
 4 funds appropriated, and federal funds in addition thereto.

1 Sec. 4. Before any funds herein appropriated shall be expended,
 2 it shall be determined by the state conservation commission, with
 3 the approval of the governor and the state comptroller, that the
 4 expenditure shall be in the best interests of the state.

1 Sec. 5. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June 30,
 2 1969, of the state appropriations of this Act made by the Sixty-
 3 first General Assembly, shall revert to the general fund of the
 4 state as of June 30, 1969.

1 Sec. 6. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence,
 2 clause or phrase of this Act is for any reason held to be
 3 unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity
 4 shall not affect the constitutionality or validity of the remain-
 5 ing portions of this Act. The General Assembly hereby declares
 6 that it would have passed this Act and each section, subsection,
 7 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase hereof irrespective of
 8 whether any one or more of the sections, subsections, paragraphs,

9 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional.

1 Sec. 7. This appropriation includes, but it not limited to
2 the following specific projects:

3	Swan Lake	\$90,000.00
4	Green Valley State Park	87,500.00
5	Spring Lake	37,400.00

1 Sec. 8. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall
 2 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and pub-
 3 lication in the Creston News Advertiser, a newspaper published
 4 at Creston, Iowa, and the Fort Dodge Messenger, a newspaper
 5 published at Fort Dodge, Iowa.

1 Amend Senate File 566 as follows: By striking section

 4 approved a project to be financed with funds herein ap-
 5 propriated, a description of said project and estimated

 7 troller for allocation of funds."
