A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the state soil conservation committee the sum of one million two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,250,000.00) to carry on soil conservation work in soil conservation districts.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
- 2 fund of the state of Iowa to the state soil conservation com-
- 3 mittee the sum of five hundred seventy-five thousand dollars
- 4 (\$575,000.00) for each year of the biennium beginning July 1,
- 5 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, or so much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary to carry on soil conservation work in soil conservation
- 7 districts organized under the soil conservation districts law of
- 8 the state of Iowa. The fund shall be used as follows:
- 9 (1) Aid to soil conservation districts for district com-
- 10 missioners' expenses, stationery, postage and other uses as they
- 11 may be authorized by the state soil conservation committee;
- 12 five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per district. Total fifty
- 13 thousand dollars (\$50,000.00).
- 14 (2) Personnel (technicians and clerical personnel), and their
- 15 necessary expenses including office rental, equipment and
- 16 materials to be assigned to the soil conservation districts by
- 17 the state soil conservation committee on a need basis; five
- 18 hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$525,000.00).
- 1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund

2 of the state of Iowa to the state soil conservation committee
3 the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) for each year
4 of the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967,
5 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used and expended
6 in participation and conjunction with the federal government or
7 any of its agencies in joint operations of watershed planning and
8 development within the state of Iowa.
